Amending Rule I-F of the Rock County Board of Supervisors Rules of Procedure

WHEREAS, the office of County Board Supervisor is an elected office; and, 1

2 3 WHEREAS, the Rock County Board of Supervisors wishes to make the process of appointing the candidates to fill vacancies an open and transparent process, 4

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Rock County Board of Supervisors duly assembled this 12th day of October, 20 23 hereby amends the Rule of Procedure of the Rock County Board of Supervisors as follows:

Rule I-F. shall be amended as follows: 1.

F. Vacancies during the term of any supervisor shall be filled by the County Board Chair with confirmation by the County Board. If practicable, this shall be done within 60 working days of the date on which the vacancy was created. If a vacancy occurs within 4 months of the next election, it may be filled at the discretion of the County Board Chair. as follows:

(1) Upon any vacancy in the position of County Board Supervisor, the County Clerk shall publicly announce a two-week solicitation period whereby electors who reside in the district where the vacancy has been created may submit their interest to the Clerk.

(2) Any person who wishes to be appointed shall submit a declaration of candidacy and nomination papers signed by at least 25 electors residing in the supervisory district in which the vacancy occurs. The signatures on the nomination papers may only be solicited by the person seeking the appointment. The submissions shall be on forms established by or required by the Wisconsin Elections Commission or any successor agency.

(3) The County Board Chair shall form a selection committee that shall make a recommendation on filling the vacancy to the County Board. The Section Committee shall be made up of seven supervisors, one of who shall be appointed as chair, and shall be selected from the membership of as many standing county board committees as practicable. Appointments to the Selection Committee shall be confirmed by the County Board.

(4) The Selection Committee shall hold one or more public hearings at location or locations within the supervisory district where the vacancy occurred. The date, time and location of the public hearing shall be determined by the chair of the selection committee. At such public hearings all candidates shall be provided an opportunity to address the committee and public, members of the selection committee shall have an opportunity to ask questions of the candidates, and members of the public shall be given an opportunity to address the committee concerning the selection of a candidate to fill the vacancy. Any candidate's failure to attend the public hearing shall disqualify them from consideration to fill the vacancy.

(5) At the conclusion of the public hearing, the Selection Committee shall recommend to the County Board which candidate to appoint to the vacancy. If in the view of the committee there are insufficient applicants, or no candidate is able to garner the support of a majority of supervisors on the committee, then the committee may extend the solicitation period by not more than four weeks from the date of the public hearing. If the Selection Committee extends the solicitation period, it shall identify the last date upon which applications may be submitted. All candidates under consideration at the time that any extension of the solicitation period occurs, shall still be under consideration until such time as a candidate is selected to fill the vacancy.

(6) The recommendation of the Selection Committee shall be forwarded to the Board at the next available meeting of the County Board, subject to the requirements of the Wisconsin Open Meetings Law. Such recommendation shall be subject to confirmation by the County Board. A person appointed herein shall serve for the remainder of the term.

(7) If practicable, the vacancy shall be filled within 60 days from the date on which the vacancy was created. If the vacancy occurs within four months of the next election in which the vacant seat would be up for election, then at the discretion of the County Board Chair, the seat may be left vacant in anticipation that it be filled by election. If the vacancy remains after the date of election, then the seat shall be filled in accordance with subsections (1)-(6), above.
