WHEREAS, the Rock County Information Technology Department is authorized to procure contracted services on behalf of the County; and,

WHEREAS, the Information Technology Department would like to purchase a twelve-month Managed Services Agreement with AVI Systems; and,

WHEREAS, with the enterprise-wide implementation and utilization of audiovisual systems, Rock-IT would like to strategically partner with AVI Systems to provide a dedicated resource to serve as primary and immediate support to achieve real time response and support for the mission-critical courtroom systems and other county locations which house audiovisual systems; and,

WHEREAS, this contract pricing is reflected in UW Contract 22-5174, and this contract was not sent to bid. The monies for this contracted agreement were budgeted in 07-1435-0000-62119 in the 2024 Budget as approved by the Rock County Board of Supervisors.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Rock County Board of Supervisors duly assembled this 11th day of January, 2024, does hereby authorize the purchase of the AVI Managed Service Agreement in an amount not to exceed \$168,000.
