Authorizing Acceptance of Anti-Heroin Task Force Grant and Amending the 2024 Sheriff's Office Budget

WHEREAS, the Wisconsin Department of Justice, Division of Criminal Investigation (DCI), has been selected as a recipient of the 2024 COPS Office Anti-Heroin Task Force; and,

WHEREAS, the Rock County Sheriff's Office has been invited to be part of the Anti-Heroin Task Force; and,

WHEREAS, the purpose of the grant is to allocate additional resources for local, multi-jurisdictional, drug task forces; and,

WHEREAS, the Rock County Sheriff's Office is eligible to receive \$10,000.00 for participating in this grant; and,

WHEREAS, grant funds will be used for only Heroin and Opioid related overtime wages; and,

WHEREAS, the grant does not require a local match; and,

WHEREAS, the grant runs from January 1, 2024, through December 31, 2024.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Rock County Board of Supervisors assembled this <u>22nd</u> day of <u>February</u> 2024, that the Rock County Sheriff is authorized to accept funds under the Anti-Heroin Task Force Grant.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the 2024 budget be amended as follows:
