**Authorizing Acceptance of Anti-Heroin Task Force Grant and Amending the 2024 Sheriff's Office Budget**

**WHEREAS**, the Wisconsin Department of Justice, Division of Criminal Investigation (DCI), has been selected as a recipient of the 2024 COPS Office Anti-Heroin Task Force; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Rock County Sheriff's Office has been invited to be part of the Anti-Heroin Task Force; and,

**WHEREAS**, the purpose of the grant is to allocate additional resources for local, multi-jurisdictional, drug task forces; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Rock County Sheriff's Office is eligible to receive \$10,000.00 for participating in this grant; and,

**WHEREAS**, grant funds will be used for only Heroin and Opioid related overtime wages; and,

**WHEREAS**, the grant does not require a local match; and,

**WHEREAS**, the grant runs from January 1, 2024, through December 31, 2024.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the Rock County Board of Supervisors assembled this 22nd day of February 2024, that the Rock County Sheriff is authorized to accept funds under the Anti-Heroin Task Force Grant.
