- ✓ Trees arrive in mid-April. The date, time, and location for picking up orders will be sent by postcard and will be posted on our website (above). We cannot hold orders so please make arrangements for someone to stop by.

- ✓ Trees are perishable! We cannot guarantee stock.
- ✓ We have three tree planters and a chemical sprayer for rent. Call for details before trees arrive.

Trees

Black Cherry, *Prunus serotina*: 18-24 inch seedlings. Fast grower in moist, well drained soils. Dark green leaves which turn yellow to red in Fall and white flowers which bloom in Spring. Edible fruit in summer. 50-60 feet tall.

Canaan Fir, *Abies balsamea* var. *Phaenolepis*: 12-18 inch seedlings. May be more tolerant of wetter soil and a variety of soil types. Makes an excellent Christmas and landscape tree. Grow 30-70 feet. **SOLD OUT**

Colorado Blue Spruce, *Picea pungens* 'Glauca': 7-15 inch seedlings. Short silvery blue-green prickly needles. Columnar to pyramidal shape. Full sun. Grows in range of soil types. Tolerates slightly wet to slightly dry. 50-75 feet tall. **SOLD OUT**

Hackberry, *Celtis occidentalis*: 18-24 inch seedlings. An excellent wildlife planting that bears small dark berries. Becomes a medium to large tree with large spreading branches. Grows excellent in adverse conditions.

Norway Spruce, *Picea abies*: 7-15 inch seedlings. Long pendants of short dark green needles hang from graceful, drooping limbs. Keeps lower branches. Excellent for windbreaks. Likes well-drained sandy loams. Full to partial sun. 35 feet tall in 20 years; up to 130 feet. **SOLD OUT**

Red Oak, *Quercus rubra*: 18-24 inch seedlings. Grows best in sandy loam; hardy in clayey to gravelly soils in medium to well-drained sunny locations. Lots of acorns. Brick red in fall. 36 feet in 20 years; up to 100 feet tall, broad and rounded. **SOLD OUT**

White Oak, *Quercus alba*: 18-24 inch seedlings. Graceful giants that define many local parks. Deep-rooted, thrive in range of well-drained soil on north and east slopes. Broad, round crown, long-lived, grows to over 100 feet tall. Purple-red in Fall. **SOLD OUT**

White Pine, *Pinus strobus* var. *lake states*: 7-15 inch seedlings. Long, soft needles in clusters of five. Fast grower. Best in full sun, moist well-drained soils. Young trees pyramidal; canopy more horizontal, layered with age. 50-80 feet tall. **SOLD OUT**

Shrubs

Nannyberry, *Viburnum lentago*: 18-24 inch seedlings. A large native tree-like shrub. Attractive for its shiny foliage, red fall color and fruit display that turns reddish, changing to bluish-black when mature. Creamy white flowers in spring. Grows in sun or shade, moist to dry sites. 12-15 feet tall. **LOW – CALL AHEAD**

Ninebark, *Physocarpus opulifolius*: 18-24 inch seedlings that form a dense, upright spreading shrub up to 9 feet tall. Bears light pink flowers in spring and red colored seeds in fall. **SOLD OUT**

Silky Dogwood, *Cornus amomum*: 12-24 inch seedlings. White flowers in spring. Blue berries in fall when foliage turns a deep red. Tolerates variety of soil conditions. Grows 4-10 feet tall. **SOLD OUT**

Root Gel & Tree Protectors

Root Dip Planting Gel is a starch absorbent that retains water and gives it back to the plant during dry periods reducing planting stress. One packet treats up to 500 seedlings. \$3 per packet.

Tree Protectors - Protect your trees from hungry deer and rabbits! Kit includes one 4 foot TUBEX plastic sleeve, one 5 foot stake, ties, and bird net. Easy to assemble. Tubes are re-useable. \$4.50 per kit if ordered by March 8, 2024.
