Clean Sweep offers a convenient, safe, and low-cost way to dispose of your unwanted hazardous chemicals. Rock County is partnering with Veolia North America to provide collection and disposal services. Please help us protect your Rock County environment through participation in this chemical collection program.

Eligibility

Businesses and organizations that generate under 220 pounds of hazardous waste in a month and store less than 2,205 pounds of hazardous waste in a year may qualify for Very Small Quantity Generator (VSQG) service at Business Clean Sweep. Veolia North America offers free guidance to help determine your eligibility to participate.

Free no-obligation quotes

Disposal fees depend on the amount and type of hazardous chemicals that you bring to the program. Veolia North America provides free, no-obligation estimates of your disposal fees - simply complete and return the inventory form enclosed or at Rock County Clean Sweep (https://www.co.rock.wi.us/departments/land-conservation/clean-sweep) under the business section. Veolia can help determine your eligibility and will guide your participation in the program, from registration through delivery of your materials.

Agricultural Chemicals

Agricultural related chemicals like pesticides or herbicides may qualify for up to 50% off disposal cost from the Wisconsin Department of Agriculture, Trade and Consumer Protection. Discount available while funds are available.


