Recognizing Alisa McCalmont

WHEREAS, Alisa McCalmont has served the citizens of Rock County for fourteen (14) years as a dedicated and valued employee of Rock County; and has made the decision to move on from Rock County as of May 10th, 2024; and,

WHEREAS, Ms. McCalmont began her career on March 22, 2010 with Rock County as an Economic Support Specialist. Ms. McCalmont has been instrumental since the beginning of her career with Rock County. She has worked with many Rock County residents assisting, guiding, and determining their eligibility for income maintenance programs and other services; and,

WHEREAS, Ms. McCalmont was one of the agents who piloted the Rock Change Center in 2011 ahead of the State Consortium Model. Where she worked with a small team managing changes for Rock, Iowa, and Crawford Counties, shortly after became part of the Southern Consortium Call Center; and,

WHEREAS, Ms. McCalmont was promoted to Consortium Training Supervisor on July 22nd, 2013. Ms. McCalmont became the first Consortium Training Supervisor where she developed systems and methods to train the largest group of trainees in Economic Support's history; and,

WHEREAS, Ms. McCalmont transitioned to Elderly, Blind, and Disabled/Long Term Care (EBD/LTC) Supervisor position on June 26th, 2017. Ms. McCalmont, advocated for our most vulnerable population. Training and leading one of the most challenging IM programs in the state, working with state committees to improve systems, processes, and policies for this population; and,

WHEREAS, Ms. McCalmont was promoted to Lead Economic Support Supervisor on December 14th, 2020 where she assisted with operations for Economic Support, provided statistical data, monitoring performance standards, served as a subject matter expert on EBD/LTC programs, Call Center Administrator, and leading Economic Support in the absence of the program manager; and,

WHEREAS, Ms. McCalmont has been instrumental in assisting with many important projects and changes in Economic Support and is extremely knowledgeable in policy and procedures, technology, systems, data, and reports. She is a team player who readily volunteered to assist whenever needed. She has tenacious personality and speaks up for and advocates for what she believes is best for the agency and the customers we serve; and,

WHEREAS, Ms. McCalmont's contributions to the Economic Support Division have been substantial and she will be greatly missed by the leadership team, her staff, customers, the consortium as well as partner agencies; and,

WHEREAS, the Rock County Board of Supervisors, representing the citizens of Rock County, wishes to recognize Alisa McCalmont for her dedication and contribution to the citizens of Rock County; and,
