 - WHEREAS, Sherry has developed various staff reorganization plans and overseen their implementation, resulting in cost savings and the prioritized use of staff resources; and,
- WHEREAS, despite a limited number of staff and a high workload in the Financial Services 26 Department, Sherry regularly offered to have Finance staff assist other departments with staff shortages 27 and workload backlogs; and,
 - WHEREAS, Sherry will retire from Rock County on July 1, 2024, after more than 17 years of service to Rock County.
 - NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Rock County Board of Supervisors duly assembled this 27th day of June, 2024, does hereby recognize Sherry Oja for her over 17 years of faithful service and recommends that a sincere expression of appreciation be given to Sherry along with best wishes for the future.
