# Creating the Ad Hoc Committee on 2026 Employee Health Insurance

WHEREAS, Rock County provides health insurance to 1,258 Rock County employees, retirees and their families, providing health benefits to over 3,500 individuals; and

**WHEREAS**, Rock County's employees, retirees, and their families, rely on the health insurance provided by Rock County to ensure their health and financial security; and

**WHEREAS**, currently, Rock County provides health insurance by contracting with two insurance plan providers, MercyCare and Dean Health Plan, who each provide a Point of Service health plan option to Rock County Employees; and,

**WHEREAS**, following years of savings after moving to a fully insured health insurance program in 2019, costs from the County's contracted providers are increasing in such a way that makes continuing; and,

**WHEREAS**, in 2024, the County Board Staff committee commenced a review of health insurance options in order to explore ways to make the County's health insurance benefits more sustainable by reducing costs, while still delivering high quality health insurance; and,

**WHEREAS**, the County Board Staff Committee has chosen to implement a 1% premium share for all County employees that complete the wellness program effective 2025, but has not otherwise changed provisions of the plan; and

**WHEREAS**, in order to provide the County Administrator, and the Rock County Board of Supervisors with the most full and complete information, a committee of stakeholders should be formed to review the options for health insurance for 2026 and report back to the County Board Staff Committee.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Rock County Board of Supervisors duly assembled this <u>27th</u> day of <u>June</u>, 2024, establishes the Ad Hoc Committee on 2026 Employee Health Insurance which shall review options presented to it by the County Administrator and Human Resources Director for purchasing or administering a <u>sustainable</u> health insurance benefit program <u>which includes</u> a <u>premium share</u> for Rock County employees, and provide comments and recommendations to the County Administrator, and the County Board Staff Committee on the selection of health insurance programs for 2026.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the above-named ad hoc committee shall make its report to the County Board Staff Committee by its second meeting in <u>June April</u> 2025. In making such report, the Ad Hoc Committee shall also make a recommendation on whether a permanent Employee Health Insurance Policy Advisory Committee should exist.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the above-named Ad Hoc Committee shall have a membership of three County Board Supervisors and fifteen Rock County employees.

 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the County Administrator is directed to establish a process to solicit and recommend employees for appointment to the Ad Hoc Committee and in doing so, shall recommend a diverse cross-section of Rock County employees, with consideration given to achieve

- representation a diverse set of experiences and viewpoints by having representatives of as many 46
- different employee types, positions, wage scales and departments as possible with priority given to 47
- achieving representation from the largest departments. The recommendation for appointments shall be 48 49
- made to the County Board Chair, who shall make such appointments consistent with Rule II.B.(1)(b).
- The term of all employee committee members shall commence on the day of the first meeting of the 50
- 51 Health Insurance Plan Advisory Committee and terminate upon the Committee making its report to the
- County Board Staff Committee. 52

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Human Resources Director, or his or her designee, as well as a representative from Rock County's contracted employee benefits consultants shall be ex officio, nonvoting members of the Committee.
