

HUNTING POLICY

EFFECTIVE: March 18, 2019

- 1. SUBJECT: Public Hunting On Southern Wisconsin Regional Airport (SWRA) Land
- 2. PURPOSE: To provide clear guidance and establish procedures for the general public to have access to SWRA, Rock County, WI owned land for the purpose of hunting deer and turkey.
- 3. SCOPE: The procedures outlined herein are for Airport Administration officials to administer and those desiring to hunt on this parcel of land to comply with.
- 4. SUPERCEDES: N/A

5. DEFINITIONS:

- A. Four (4) deer hunting permits may be granted annually by airport officials. These can only be used within the approved Wisconsin DNR regular bow or gun seasons. No fee.
- B. Four (4) turkey hunting permits may be granted annually by airport officials. These can only be used within the approved Wisconsin DNR regular bow or gun seasons. No fee.
- C. No more than four (4) permit holders will be granted access during the same time period.
- D. All hunting shall be contained within airport owned land. See attachment 1. Trail cameras and non-permanent tree stands may be used.
- E. Hunters must comply with all Wisconsin DNR rules.
- F. Hunters must request access of neighboring land owners should an injured animal transverse properties. Airport officials will not be responsible for hunters trespassing without land owner consent.

6. PROCEDURES:

- A. Airport Administration shall provide hunting information at www.jvlairport.com. The site will provide the basic information to the public of when and where to obtain a permit.
- B. The Airport Administration staff will issue permits no earlier than 7:00 am on the first advertised day of availability on a first come-first served basis. The permit holder must be present with proper identification. One registered permit holder may not receive a



second permit for a family member or friend. No call-in holds, email-holds, or reservations shall be accepted – no exceptions.

- C. Airport staff will record all information and notify the Rock County Sheriff's Office of those granted access to hunt on airport property.
- D. Any violations such as leaving garbage behind, leaving gates open, damage to property, intentional killing of animals other than those in season, harassing other hunters, etc., will be grounds to revoke hunting privileges on Airport property indefinitely.
- E. All hunters must report type and number of animals killed at the end of the season by calling 608-757-5768.
