Hi, Jennifer:

The Building Committee met this morning and provided the following information.

1. The main entrance to the United Way Community Services building is located off of Main Street, and thus is never locked during business hours (only exception being an extenuating circumstance). The employee only entrance, is not the primary and is located on the south side of the facility. The handicap accessible stalls are located in front of the facility, closest to the main entrance. Also, there are handicap stalls in each of the building's two parking lots, on the south and north side of the building.
2. There are a total of two side entrances, one with a curb and one with steps. Both of which are considered emergency exits. Again, the community enters through the main entrance – and there are ramps into the parking lots.
3. There is lighting available in the front area, though the committee will explore whether or not it is sufficient.
4. With regard to a Beloit office, the location of the United Way offices is a board approved decision based upon myriad factors. Paramount being economic efficiency and responsible stewardship. Thus, it was no longer sustainable to maintain multiple offices within one region. The vital services provided by United Way funding have not changed, and are administered not only in Beloit – but communities in all of Rock County and northern Winnebago county.

Again, thanks for forwarding these concerns. Hopefully this helps to clarify the misperceptions with regard to the facility.

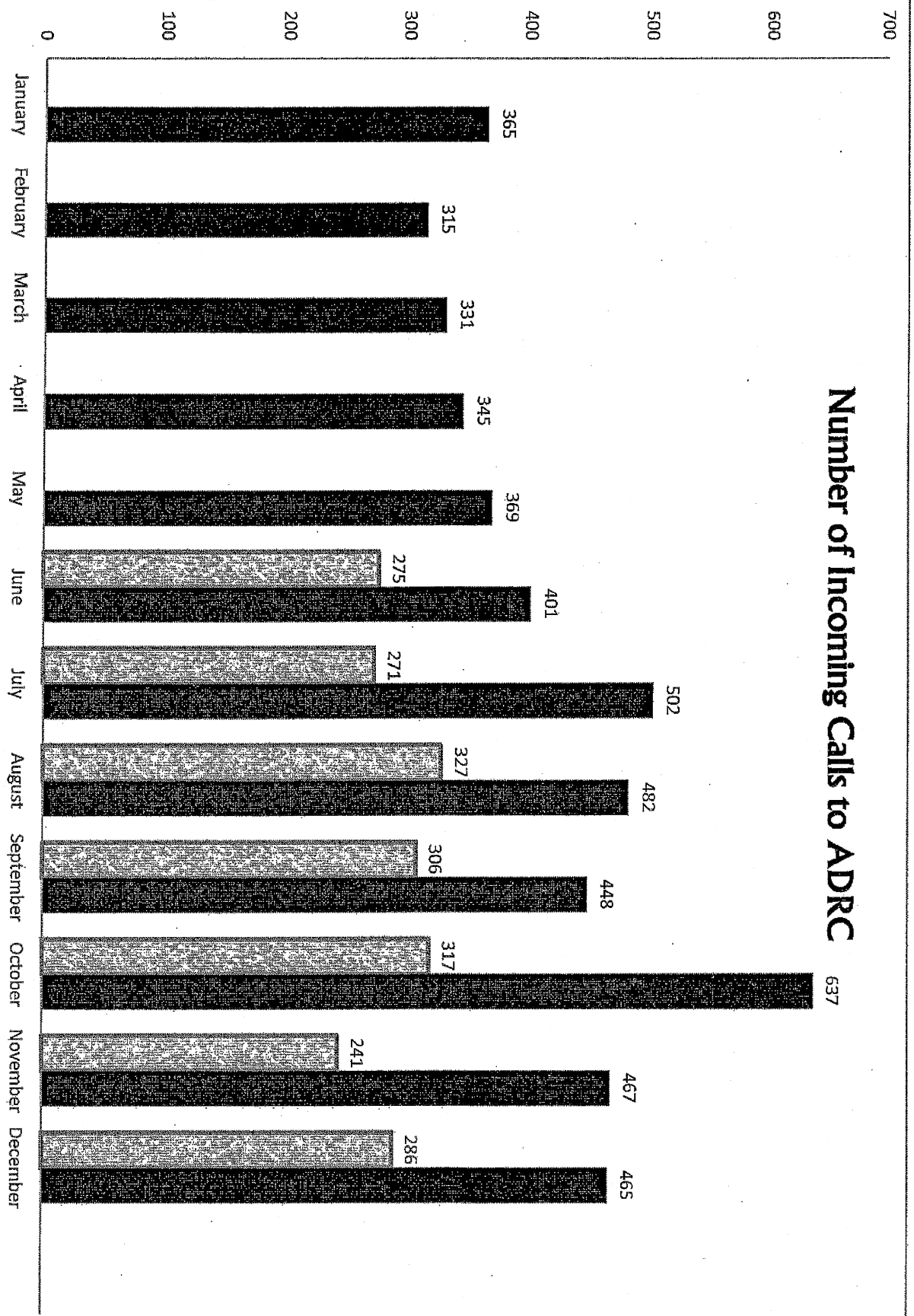

Number of Incoming Calls to ADRC

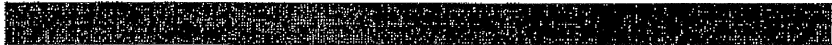
